At North Charleston Creative Arts Elementary we use an arts integrated approach which combines the fine and performing arts with the core instructional program. We hold the distinction as an Arts in Basic Curriculum site, along with recognition from The Distinguished Arts Program. Additionally, our identification as a Title 1 school affords us access to federal funding to provide targeted instruction and interventions for all students.

We ensure our students have access to an array of fine arts programs, each one embedded into the fabric of our school.

- Visual Arts: Focuses on instilling creativity and confidence in all students through the development of motor skills, language skills, social skills, decision-making, and risktaking.
- Dance: Exposes our students to a variety of styles like jazz, ballet, tap, & modern.
 The program embraces creative movement and aligns with cross-curricular units in the core content areas.
