This report is provided annually to highlight the progress of St. Helena Elementary School. It presents information regarding our challenges and successes during the 2017-2018 school year.



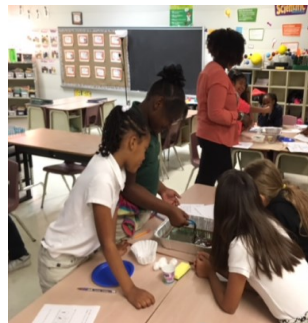
## School Mission
