School Area Goals

Teaching and Learning/Continuous Improvement:

This year our teachers continued meeting weekly as Professional Learning Communities (PLCs). During their meetings, teams worked on analyzing student data, setting SMART goals, and tracking student progress. Teachers received the support and coaching from our school instructional leaders to help build upon teaching strategies and techniques. Another goal our school has worked on this year is developing classroom libraries to increase our male reader's engagement. Some methods to support this goal were to survey students and teachers to gain insight. Additionally, our school continues to work on monitoring and adjusting our Strategic Plan that the school will implement throughout the following years. One part of the strategic plan is to highlight is our implementation of Ci3T- Comprehensive Integrated 3-Tier Model of Prevention. Through Ci3T our school has developed school-wide expectations for academics, behavior, and social-emotional learning.

Leadership and Communication:

Weekly we send out both a Parent and Staff newsletter. The Parent Newsletter is emailed to all families, posted to our school's website, and shared with staff. We've also committed to utilizing our social media pages to help disseminate information. Additionally, Blackboard messaging helps to communicate more urgent information through message blasts, either through a phone call or a text message.

Resources, Safety, and Student Support:

We strive to maintain a 95% satisfaction rating on our social and physical environment from students, parents, and teachers. Some ways we keep our rating include having a full-time security officer, training teachers on the continued need for student support in social and emotional needs, and sharing monthly safety newsletters with staff. We also receive input regarding resources and safety from our staff and students through observations and school-initiated surveys.
