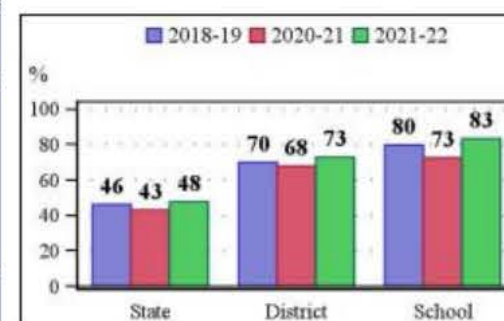

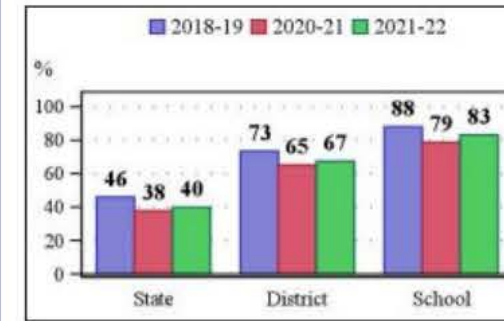
According to the Niche Study, TCES was recognized as the #3 public school in South Carolina!
