When comparing student assessment data from previous school years to the assessment data collected during the 2020 - 2021 school year, it was noted that in spite of the unavoidable COVID-19 guarantine shut down of schools across the country, Tega Cay Elementary School students met or surpassed the typical growth compared to other students in South Carolina. An increase in average points\* (+9.2 Reading and +28 Math) shows that not only did our students "makeup" for the loss of in person teaching and learning due to COVID, but many are above their typical growth expectations for this time of year. This success is not an accident. It is the diligent work of our Titan Teachers and Staff who truly embrace the Solution Tree's Professional Learning Communities mindset that "all students are our students" and that "all students can succeed." Additionally, we share our success with the community we serve. Our families have been very supportive throughout this pandemic and have had the mindset of "we're all in this together.
