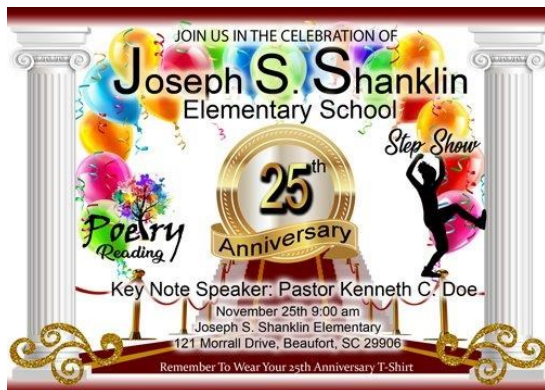
### **GOALS**
