Joseph S. Shanklin Elementary School is fully accredited by AdvancED.


The current 2018 Accreditation Classification by the South Carolina State Department of Education is listed as "All Clear".



GOALS


- Increase student achievement by 2019 to exceed state and national averages

MAP assessments provide mean RIT scores for each grade level which are calculated from the individual RIT scores for all children in that grade. RITs are used as a measure of student growth on a learning continuum in reading and in math.
