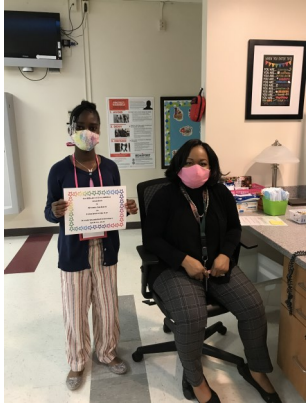
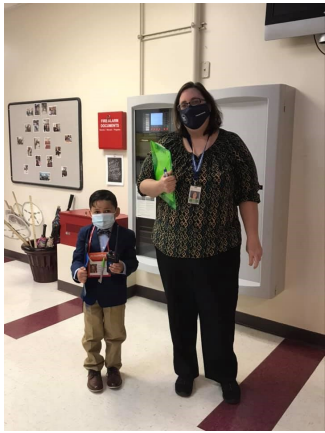
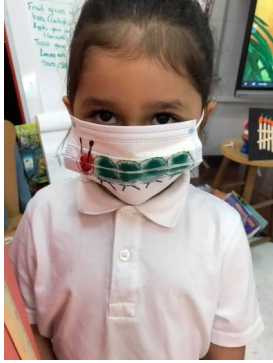

School Renewal Plan Goals

Student Achievement: By 2023-2024, the percentage of students scoring at the proficiency levels "Met or Exceeds" will increase from 19% to 42% in ELA and from 28% to 45% in Mathematics on SCREADY

Student Achievement: By 2023-2024, the percentage of students scoring at the proficiency levels "Met or Exceeds" will increase from 25% to 35% in Science and from 34.4% to 40% in Social Studies on SCPASS

Teacher/Administrator Quality: By 2023-2024, certified staff teachers successfully completing SIOP training will increase from 70 to 90%.

School Climate: By 2023-2024, Joseph Shanklin will successfully recertify as a Leader in Me Lighthouse School by moving 10 of the 30 Leader in Me Lighthouse rubric indicators up one level.
