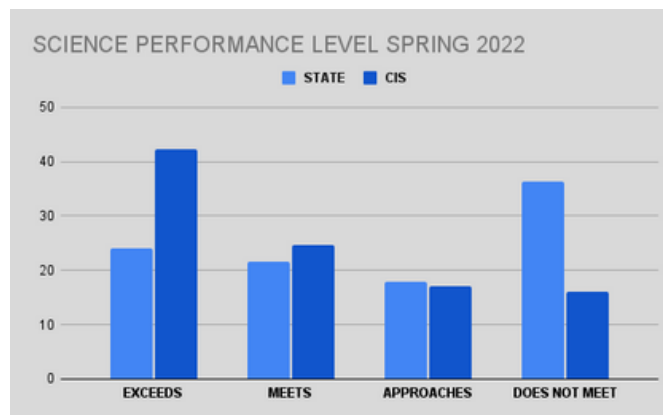
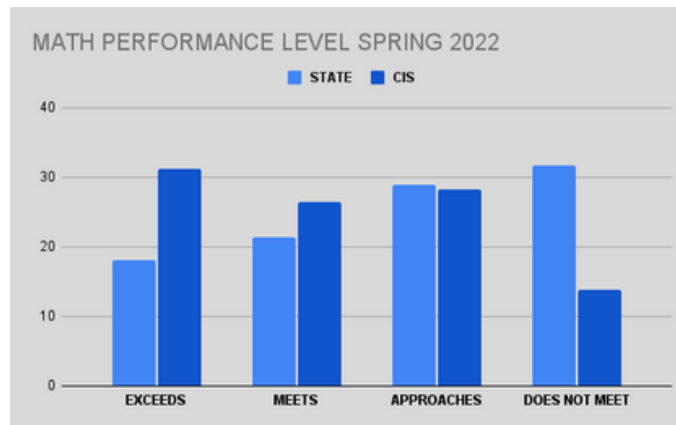
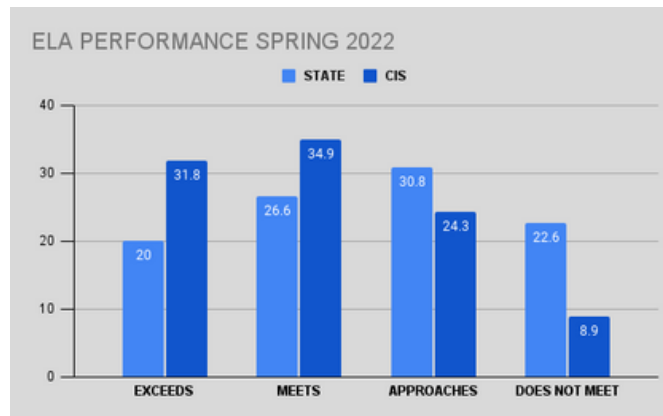
## Student Achievement
