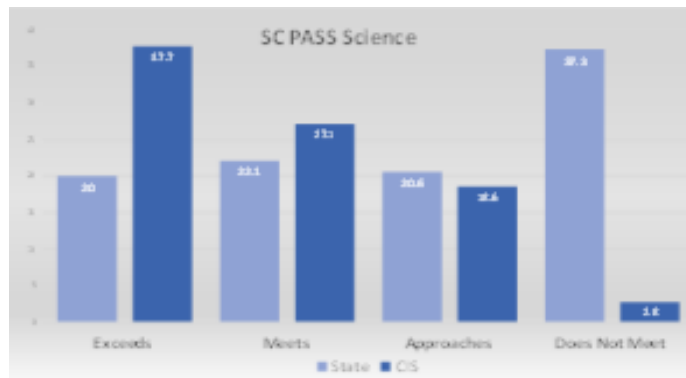
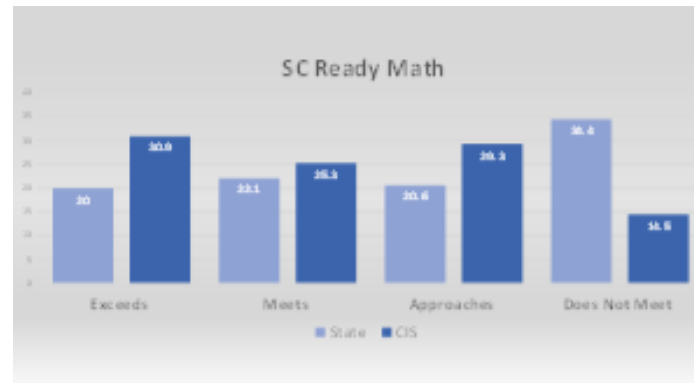
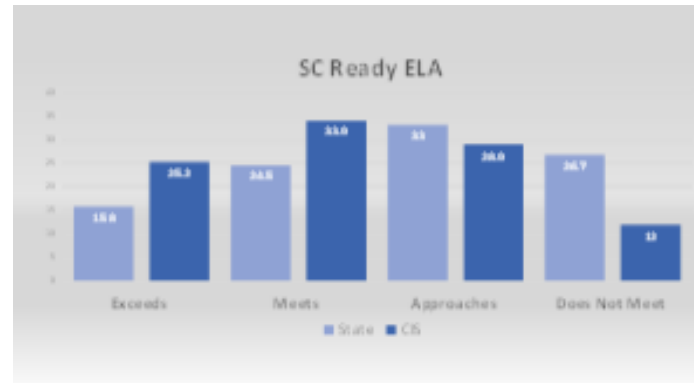
The table below identifies the percentage of CIS that Meets & Exceeds vs. the State score. The next page reflects graphs for all categories.
