Performance Goals 2022-2026

- Improve the academic achievement of all students by increasing the total percentage of students meeting Approaches, Meets and Exceeds on the SC Ready ELA assessment from 88% to 92% by meeting projected annual target goals below by 2026.
- Improve the academic achievement of all students by increasing the total percentage of students meeting Approaches, Meets and Exceeds on the SC Ready Math assessment from 94% to 98% by meeting projected annual target goals below by 2026.
- Recruit, hire, train, and retain quality, world-class teachers, and personnel by increasing the number of teachers that have their Read 2 Succeed endorsement from 32% to 43% by 2026.
- Oakridge Elementary will use staff and family input to create a safe learning environment for students resulting in a strongly agree or agree rating of 82% to 87% or higher as determined by the K-12 climate survey.
- Increase the academic achievement of students with disabilities by increasing the total percentage of students who meet or exceeds expectations on SC READY ELA from 21.4% to 72.2%.
- Improve the percentage of students that are considered below grade level on i-Ready reading in K, 1st and 2nd grade from 20% to 12% by 2026.
