Performance Goals 2017-2021

- Improve the academic achievement of all students by increasing the percentage of students in the Meets Expectations and Exceeds Expectations Categories on the SC Ready English assessment. Target growth for third grade will increase from 73.7% to 79.76%, 60.4% to 65.38% in fourth grade and 60.2% to 66.16% in fifth grade by the year 2021.
- Improve the academic achievement of all students by increasing the percentage of students in the Meets Expectations and Exceeds Expectations Categories on the SC Ready Math assessment. Target growth for third grade will increase from 87.4% to 90.94%, 83.3% to 86.67% in fourth grade and 78.5% to 81.68% in fifth grade by the year 2021.
- Provide a physically, socially and academically nurturing environment for all students, staff, and stakeholders by increasing the percentage of staff that strongly agree all students are aware of the safety and security procedures from 72 to 78 percent by 2021.
- Recruit, hire, train, and retain quality, world-class teachers, and personnel by increasing the number of teachers that have their Read 2 Succeed endorsement from 13 to 22 by 2021.
