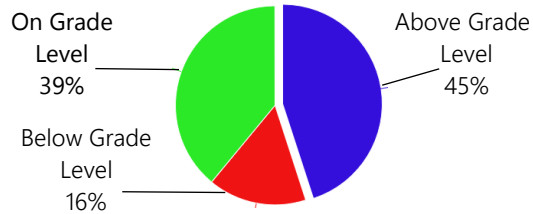


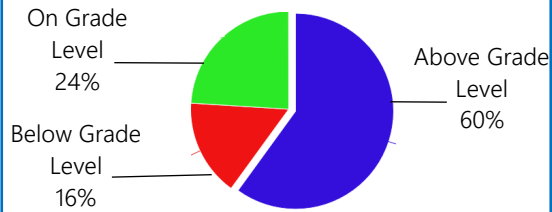

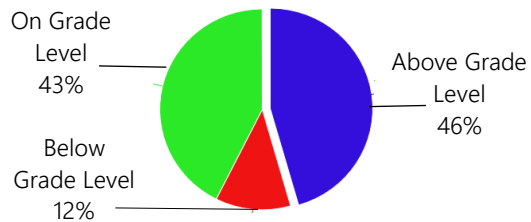
2017-2018 Sand Hill Elementary
