

# 2025-26 School Goals

By May 2026, the percentage of students who meet or exceed on SC Ready reading will go from 76.1% to 79.1%.

By May 2026, the percentage of students who meet or exceed on SC Ready math will increase from 54.6% to 60.1%.

By May 2026, the percentage of Special Education students who meet or exceed on SC Ready reading will increase from 16.4% to 29.6%.

By May 2026, the School Climate for students will increase from a baseline of 38% to 50% as measured by the Student Panorama Survey.

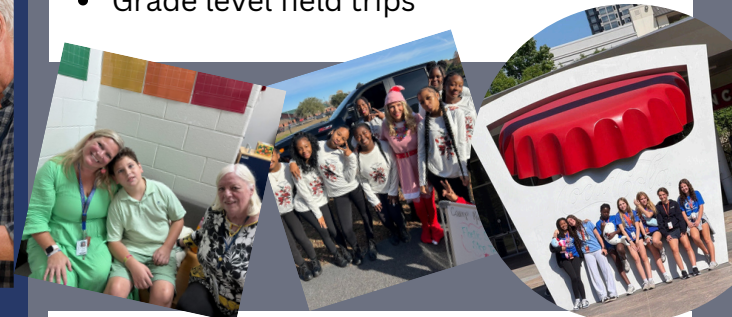
## 2025-2026 Vision
