National Honor

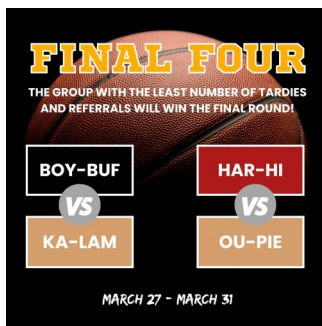

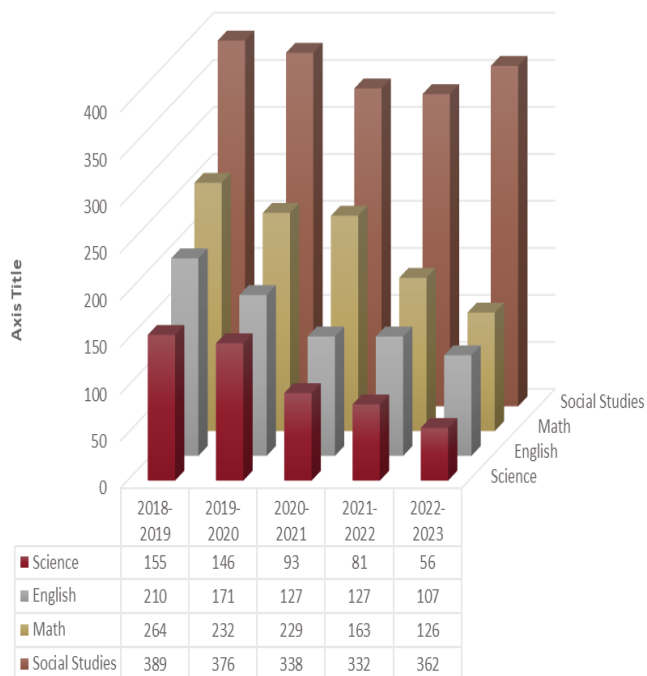
