Busbee Elementary School, a preK-5th grade Title I school, is helping all students develop the *World Class Skills of the Profile of the South Carolina Graduate* by providing a safe, caring, and academically challenging teaching and learning environment through the implementation of our school's mission.

Our mission is to be a community of leaders dedicated to *recognizing the worth and potential* in each student as we prepare them to be *future ready leaders* and *life-long learners*.

During the 2019-2020 school year, our school worked with intentionality to specifically focus on the following characteristics of the Profile: *World Class Knowledge* – rigorous standards in language arts and math for career and college readiness; *World Class Skills* – critical thinking and problem solving, collaboration and teamwork, communication, information, technology, knowing how to learn; and *Life and Career Characteristics*– integrity, self-direction, global perspective, perseverance, work ethic, and interpersonal skills.

The rapid introduction of Distance Learning came about during our unprecedented school closure due to the world-wide pandemic.
