Ridge Spring-Monetta Middle School is in Year 5 as a middle school, having been a combined middle high school previously. The SIC this year, was developed to help support the initiatives of achievement and building a positive school culture. As such, our goals for next year are:

About Ridge Spring-Monetta Middle School:

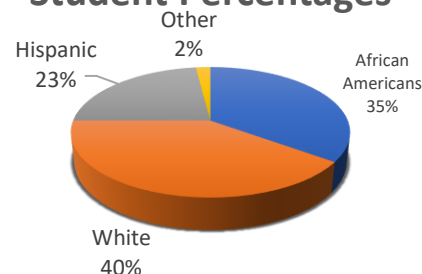
