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#### HEALTH SCIENCE



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## Achievements

- ✓ The 2021 senior class received over \$1,715,200 in scholarships and finished with a 98.3% graduation rate. 86.8% of seniors were accepted to postsecondary education, 5.6% enlisted in the military and 7.6% joined the workforce after graduation.
