Innovative Learning & Resources

Artsonia — Coosa student artwork is displayed online in a Student Art Gallery at <u>artsonia.com</u>. Our gallery continues to grow. Currently, there are more than 19,500 works of student art published on our Artsonia gallery. We have had almost 55,000 visitors to the site. For busy families and family members far away, it is a great way to see what our students at Coosa are doing in the art room.

Brain Boosters — A 1^{st} and 2^{nd} grade curriculum resource that encourages critical thinking and problem solving.

Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) — Classes designed to challenge qualifying 3^{rd} , 4^{th} , and 5^{th} grade students.

Instructional Coach — Our instructional coach focuses on teacher professional development and teaching "best practices".
