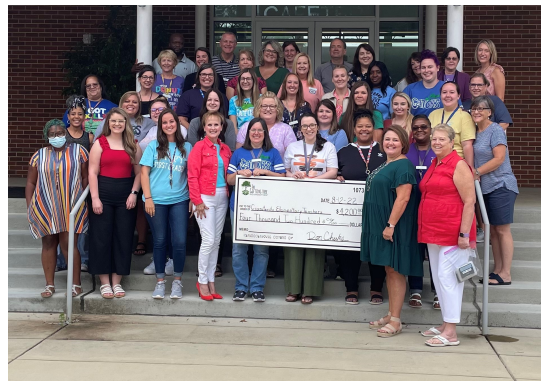
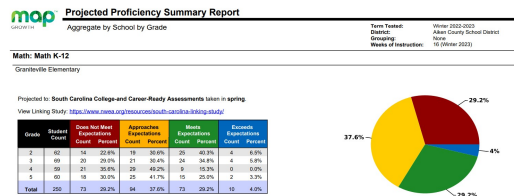
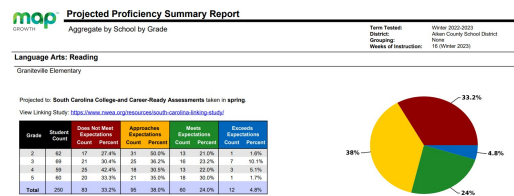
By June 2023, Graniteville SIC will engage parents to:
