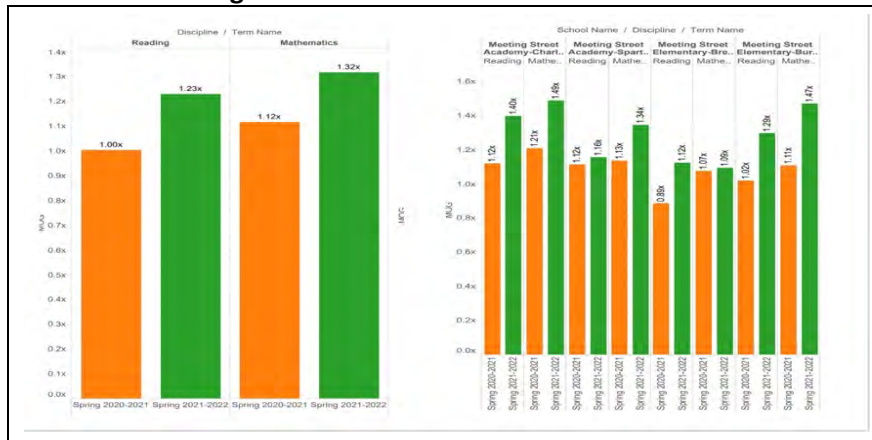
Instructional Goals
