

School Goals

- The percentage of fifth through eighth grade students scoring Meets and Exceeds on the ELA portion of SC Ready will increase to 47% by May 2024 as measured by SC Ready.
- The percentage of 5th through 8th grade students scoring meets or exceeds on the Mathematics portion of the SC Ready will increase from 26.10 % in May of 2018 to 55% by May 2024 as measured by the SC READY. .
- By 2024, 90% of all certified teachers will be proficient (or above) on Student Learning Objective EOY Results.
- By 2019, we will increase of number of active volunteers from four (4) to ten (10).
- By 2024, Whale Branch Middle School will decrease the number of office referrals to 350.
