Findings for Student Achievement:

•Fall MAP scores show that 42% of students are above grade level in Math.

•Fall MAP scores show that 57% of students are above grade level in Reading.

•Many of our students are attending in-person school for the first time in a year and a half.

Baselines are being established for all SC End of Course (EOC) tests in Algebra and Biology this year.

Accomplishments and Achievements

- Students have competed at the Varsity and Sub-Varsity levels in Fall, Winter, and Spring Athletics. Athletes in Cross Country, Swimming, and Wrestling have qualified for region and state recognition.
- FIHS music programs in band, chorus, orchestra, and winterguard have all earned a variety of distinctions this year.
- FIHS choral program earned a "Superior Rating with Distinction" for SC CPA. They performed at Carowinds Music in the Parks Festival earning straight Superior ratings.
- FIHS symphonic band earned Excellent rating at SC CPA and "Superior Rating with Distinction" at Carowinds Music in the Parks Festival.
- FIHS Orchestra earned a Superior Rating at SC CPA.
- Four visual arts students have qualified for membership inNational Art Honor Society.
- 46 students were inducted into the National Beta Club.
- All students completed multiple service hours on the first annual Day of Service.
- FIHS boys' basketball team went undefeated in the regular season.
- 65 students earned OSHA 10 certification through IAE courses.
