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SIC Annual Goals

The goals identified by the School Improvement Council for this year are as follows:

- By 2022 75% of student inmates enrolled in school will earn a certification in WIN, HS Diploma, or its equivalency, Career Technical Education, or Employability skills.
- Allendale HS will increase the number of GEDs earned in 2021 by 45% in 2022.

Our goal is to increase the number of student inmates served and ensure that each student inmate that leaves the institution leaves with some type of credential. To date Allendale is on target of surpassing its second goal despite the challenges in providing instruction *caused* by the pandemic.

Student Achievement

To date Allendale HS students have received six (6) High School Equivalency Diplomas and over 150 OJT certificates.

Additional Information

Allendale High School struggles with sufficient access to students, lock downs, and proper certified staff to deliver instruction at the appropriate levels. Most students enter after their graduation date, with an average of 10 credits and one year remaining incarcerated. On the average, incarcerated students are in school up to three hours per day. Allendale High School has aggressively worked to obtain transcripts, screen students, determine pathway of completion

due to testing material, lack of student access caused by the pandemic, lockdowns, and other programs.

The pathway to re-entry through education whose goal is combine the resources of two of South Carolina Department of Corrections departments: Education and Programs, Reentry and Rehabilitative Services were also established this year.
