SIC Annual Goals

Broad River High School will ensure 80% - 100% of inmate students who enter without a credential exit with at least one work readiness credential to include, HS Diploma, HS Equivalency Diploma, WIN certificate, Vocational Certificate, Employability Skills Certificate, or Apprenticeship.

To ensure this goal was met, a checklist in the form of a spreadsheet of educational goals for each student, including her respective release dates to ensure the deadlines are met was implemented.

- 73 % of the students currently attending Broad River High School achieved a level gain in either mathematics or reading this school term
- 90% of the students will achieve an Employability Skills Certificate
- 70% have received a WIN certificate.

Broad River High School is helping all students develop the World Class Skills of the *Profile of the South Carolina Graduate* by ... providing a strong vision for staff and students to understand and embrace our purpose. On a daily basis staff work closely with students with deliberate steps to provide and enhance opportunities for a successful return to society. Teachers vary their instructional methods incorporating direct, face-to-face instruction, virtual education, hands-on applications, small group instruction, and whole class instruction. Teachers and students use a combination of print-based materials and digital content. WIN and GED tests are completed in a secure testing area with a certified test administrator. We offer courses to allow students to complete the requirements for a High School diploma, High School Equivalency diploma, and WIN Ready to Work Certificate. The expectation is that each student exiting our school will be educated and empowered to become employable, self-sufficient citizens. A student advisory council has been established comprised of students, teacher's assistants, and a teacher's advisor. This group meets monthly and explores needs of the school and students in an effort to improve the quality of education.
