SIC Annual Goals

Lee High School set performance goals in the following areas: Teacher/Administrator Quality and Student Achievement. The 2021-2022 goal for Teacher/Administrator goal was to have 80% to 90% of the teacher staff certified to provide secondary level instruction.

The 2021-2022 goal for Student achievement was to ensure 80% to 100% of incarcerated individuals to exit with at least one work readiness credential to include a High School diploma, High School Diploma Equivalency, WIN (WorkKeys) certificates, vocational credentials, employment skills or apprenticeship.

Student Achievement

Lee High School is proud to share our student achievements from the last two academic school years. Despite COVID restrictions and quarantine mandates, LHS was able to obtain two high school equivalency diplomas, 104 vocational credentials, 16 WIN (WorkKeys) credentials, 62 On-the-Job (OJTs) training certificates, and 2 Employability Skills curriculum completions.
