SIC Annual Goals

Lee High School set performance goals in the following areas: Teacher/Administrator Quality and Student Achievement. The 2022-2023 goal for Teachers/Administrators was to have 80% to 90% of the teacher staff certified to provide secondary level instruction.

The 2022-2023 goal for Student achievement was to ensure 80% to 100% of incarcerated individuals exit with at least one work readiness credential, including a High School diploma, High School Diploma Equivalency, WIN (WorkKeys) certificates, vocational credentials, employment skills or apprenticeship.

Student Achievement

Lee High School continues to strive toward academic success. Despite recovering from COVID restrictions and quarantine mandates, LHS obtained five high school equivalency diplomas, 36 vocational credentials, 63 On-the-Job (OJTs) training certificates, and nine Employability Skills curriculum completions.
