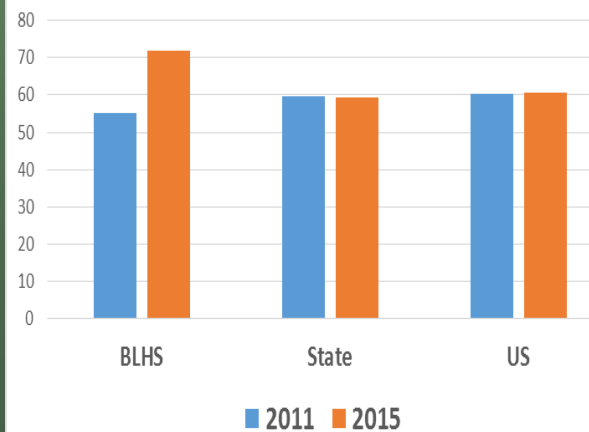

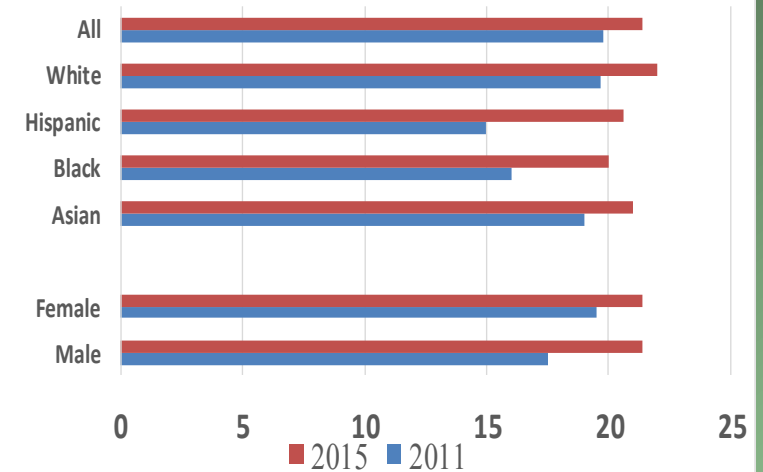

BLHS to State & Nation



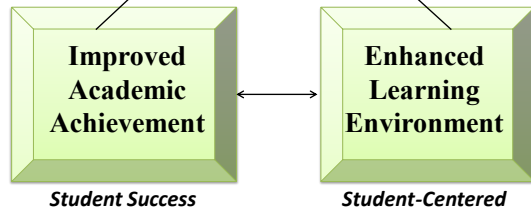

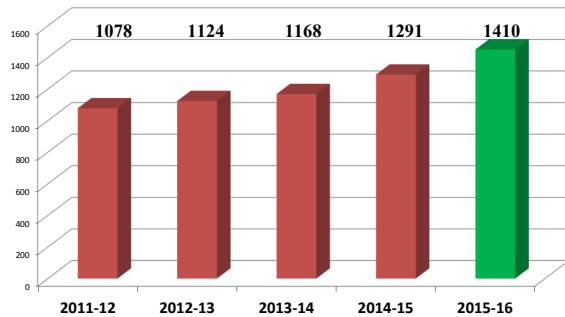

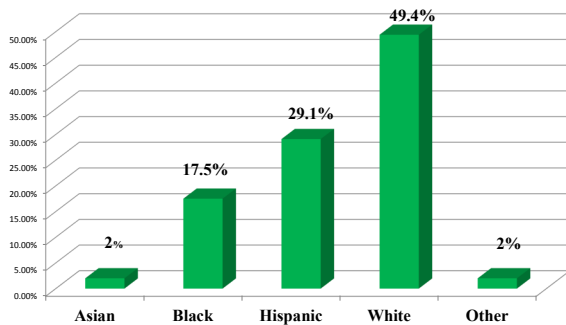
