- ⇒ Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Currciulum: Into Reading and Into Math are the curriculums that have been implemented to ensure our students are challenged academically
- ⇒ **Reflex Math:** program designed to build math skills
- ⇒ **Smarty Ants:** platform that builds foundational reading skills in an interactive and adaptive learning environment
- ⇒ Certified and Non-certified Interventionists: assist students with building literacy skills.
- ⇒ AMIRA: An intervention that is designed to gauge academic progress of students. assesses oral reading fluency and analyzes errors to pinpoint strengths and weaknesses. The data received from the assessments is used to improve teaching and learning.
