Strategies to Increase our Graduation Rate

Administrators & Counselors will engage in the following...

- Schedule admin meeting with the parents of students in the red zone and share an action plan
- Weekly monitoring of students in red zone by Principal, counselors, and any other supportive team member (student's request)
- Update the "Stop Light Report" at the end of each quarter of instruction – students with a substantial passing average at the end of the quarter will be shifted to the green zone. Students who fail or have borderline averages will be placed in the red zone and strategies for students in the red zone will be enacted.
- Conduct a SUNS Number query to see if any of the students with an unknown status are enrolled in another SC High School
