Instructional Program at HHIECC

It is our goal to meet the needs of all our students. We offer a Balanced Literacy Program which includes a Reading and Writing Workshop Model. Components include a Literacy Mini-Lesson, followed by Shared Reading/Writing as well as Guided Reading and Writing with Small-Group Instruction. Students are able to practice their skills in their individualized Literacy Centers and apply these skills in Independent Reading and Independent Writing. We also follow a Guided Math Model based on Everyday Math. Social-Studies, Science, and Health are addressed through our Curriculum Units in Kindergarten. We offer experiences in Music, Media, Explorations, Art, Computer, and PE through our Special Areas. Pre-K follows the Creative Curriculum Model.
