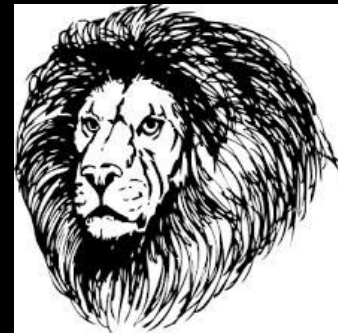

Dear Parents,

This report gives essential data to partners and stakeholders inside our local community. It is Manning Junior High School's desire to be one of the best schools in South Carolina. The School Improvement Council plays a functioning and positive role in supporting this idea.

During the 2022-2023 school year, Manning Junior High School has continued some of the same initiatives that have proven to be successful in years past. We have students meeting expectations for the Honor Roll and/or the National Jr. Beta Club.

The Original Six Foundation Practice Makes Perfect After-school Program is in its 7th year at MJHS. It is a program where students work hard to improve their classroom learning through the completion of homework assignments and tutoring.

Students at MJHS are offered other opportunities to enrich their learning during afterschool hours due to daily Advisory/Acceleration time and Teacher Office hours. Each teacher provides at least one hour of academic assistance on a weekly basis. During this time, students receive extra help, tutoring, and/or make up assignments.

With our partnership with Discovery Education, we provide a simple to use STEM learning platform that combines dynamic curated curriculum resources with on-demand teaching strategies, personalized to fit the needs of all teachers and students. This program content brings excitement and relevancy to topics taught so that all students have opportunities to unlock their true potential.

Lastly, all students at MJHS continue to have access to the learning platforms Achieve 3000, ALEKS, Read 180, and Math 180 initiatives that provide digital curriculum and assessments, integrating technology and content into everyday instruction. Fundamentals of Computing, a high school credit course, was also offered to our 8th grade students again this year.
