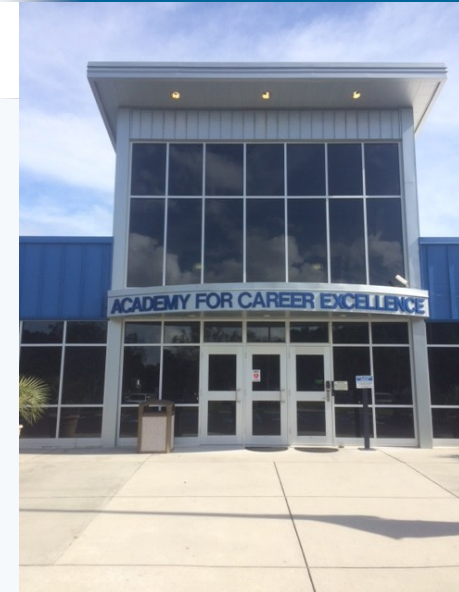

The ACE Board of Education, faculty, staff, and administration affirm that ACE intends to emerge as a state and national leader in career and technical education and workforce development.

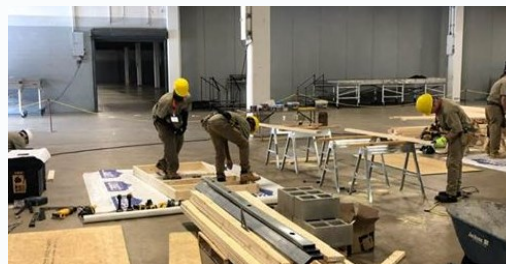
