The faculty and staff of Jefferson Elementary School strive to provide our students with a positive learning environment and a strong academic program that will meet their individual needs. Data is used to determine strengths and weaknesses. Each student is treated as a unique individual and supported as they become lifelong learners.

Jefferson Elementary is a Title I school. Currently, the poverty percentage is 75.23%. During the 2015-2016 School Year, Title I funds were used to provide an extra teacher and instructional aide in kindergarten to reduce the number of students in each class. Funds were also used to provide a part-time instructional aide and parent-involvement aide. Instructional classroom resources were also purchased to allow students the opportunity to access more reading material on their instructional level. A certified tutor was also hired for students in grades 3-5 to provide additional support in the area of reading. The monetary support also allowed for the purchase of LCD projectors, bulbs, intervention materials, and other instructional materials.
