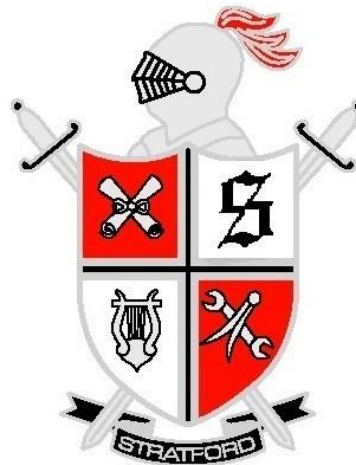
Snapshot of Accomplishments
