Stratford's Four A's

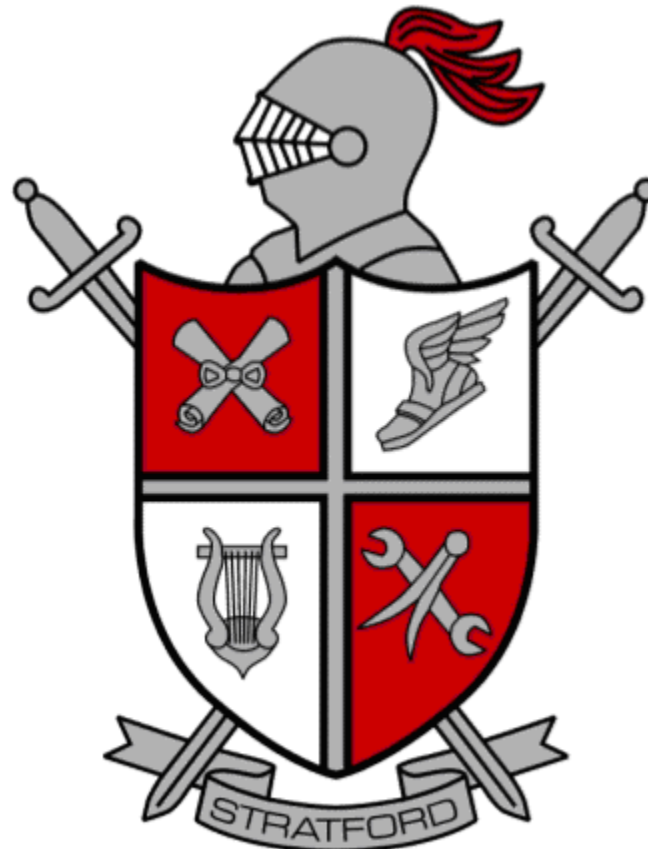

Snapshot of Accomplishments

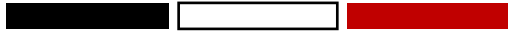
- In 2022-2023 Stratford performed above the district and state through End of Course Assessments in Algebra 1, Biology, and U.S. History.
- There were 138 students who completed a CTE program of study.
- Stratford's 2023 seniors received academic scholarships in excess of \$9,312,889 and athletic scholarships totaling over \$502,000.
- Stratford held its first Family Engagement Day which connected businesses and services to Stratford families in the surrounding community. The event also tripled the amount of parent feedback that SHS received on the Parent School Climate Survey.
- Stratford High Band earned the Outstanding Performance Award for the 22-23 school year. The OPA is the most prestigious award that SCBDA gives each year to SC band programs.

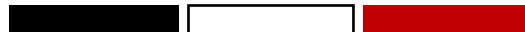
