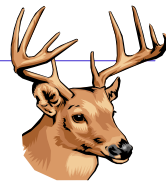

School Renewal Plan Goals

Student Achievement

- The percentage of students passing End-of-Course Exams will increase from 52% in June 2010 to 75.5% in June 2016.
- The on-time graduation rate for BHS students will increase from 59.7% in June 2010 to 75% in June 2016.
- The percentage for students who achieve a passing score on all subtests of the HSAP on the first attempt will increase from 75.6% in June 2010 to 83% in June 2016.
- The Longitudinal HSAP passing rate will increase from 86.2% in June 2010 to 94.3% in June 2016.

Instructional Leadership to Increase Student Achievement

- 100% of staff will meet the NCLB definition of HQ through the year 2016.
- Our school will be responsible stewards of our resources and insure that we stay 100% within the guidelines of our budget through the year 2016.

Goals to Increase Parent Involvement and Promote a Safe and Healthy School.
