Personnel / Athletic Accomplishments

- Twenty-six athletes received All Region Awards.

- Two Softball athletes participated in North-South All-Star Games.

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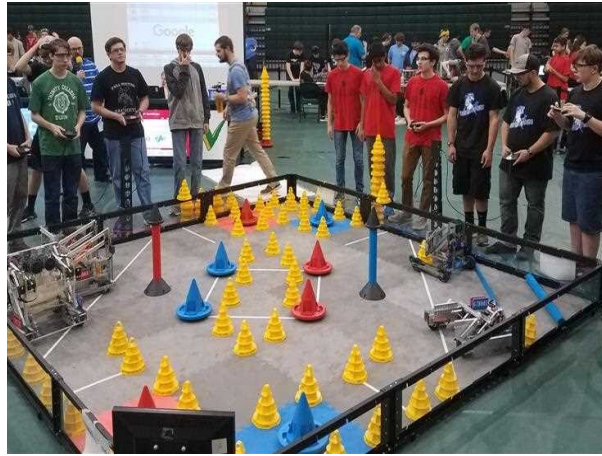

Academic & Civic Accomplishments

- Midland Valley started the EARLY COLLEGE program with 18 students in its first cohort. An additional 28 students were enrolled in the 2nd cohort of the Early College Program.
- These students will earn an Associates degree while they earn a High School diploma.
- Graduation Rate of 89.5%
- MVHS offers AP U.S. History, AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Language, AP Literature, AP Chemistry, AP Environmental Science, AP Human Geography, AP World History, AP Psychology, AP European History, and AP Studio Art.
- MVHS students taking courses at the Aiken County Career & Technology Center have repeatedly clinched district, state, and national titles.
- Community service projects included the following: Valley's Empty Stocking Fund, Relay for Life, Special Olympics, American Heart Association, Coat and Food Drives, The United Way of Aiken, Feed the Kid program, and The Debbie Knight Foundation.
- Staff members have donated over \$30,000 to local charities over the last seven years.
