


### Midland Valley High School

John Burke, Class AAAA's top-ranked wrestler in the 285-pound class, wasted little time backing up his ranking at Upper State. He reached the final against Catawba Ridge's Tony Atkina and pinned him in just 39 seconds.

Burke was a top seed at the state championships - he also qualified in 2021 and 2022, finishing fourth both times.
