Sangaree Elementary School is a primary school serving over 730 students between the ages of 4 and 7.

Our teachers are always seeking to learn new and effective strategies to use in the classroom such as: digital learning, science exploration kits, small group guided reading and math instruction, Accelerated Reader, reading and math interventions and through the use of hands on learning.

The staff continues to analyze all available test data and classroom performance to determine areas that require curriculum refinement. We are proud of our strong history of academic success. At Sangaree Elementary we also have various programs outside the academic world to focus on the development of the whole child.

School-wide we have focused on embedding character education into our curriculum. This year we continued to use the Positive Behavior Interventions and Support (PBIS) program. This program rewards our students for displaying positive behaviors. Our guidance department presents character education topics in weekly classroom guidance lessons. Sangaree also partnered with the Roscoe Reader program where students received books for reading and taking quizzes on what they read.

At Sangaree Elementary we believe the school, family, and community must share the educational responsibility of our young. Thank you for all of your support in helping in the development of our future SC graduates and world leaders!
