## SC READY STATE TESTING DATA FROM 2021-2022

The South Carolina College and Career-Ready Assessments (SC READY) program is a statewide assessment in English Language Arts (ELA), mathematics, and science administered to students in grades 3–8 as required by the Education Accountability Act (EAA). Grades 6-8 take the ELA and Math assessments, while grade 6 also takes the Science assessment.

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRESS 2022-2023**

Paul Knox uses NWEA MAP testing to measure academic progress throughout the school year. The NWEA MAP test is a nationally normed test that sets growth goals for students as we seek to grow and improve academic progress throughout the year.
