Highlights of 2021-2022

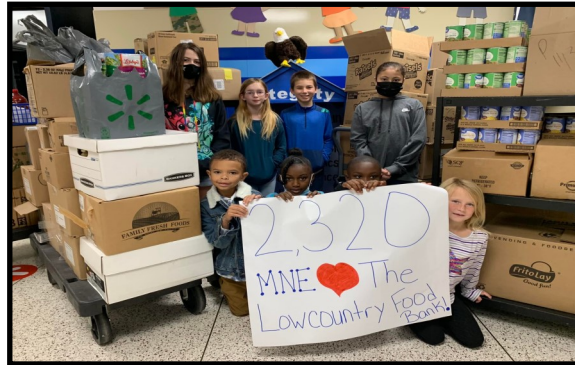
- The MNE House System was expanded to include competitions between the houses. These competitions included: Food Drive, Toy Drive, Penny Drive, etc.
