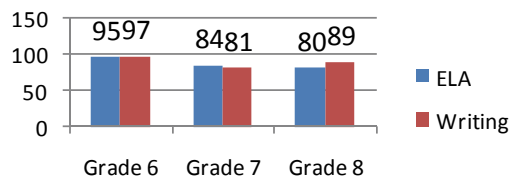
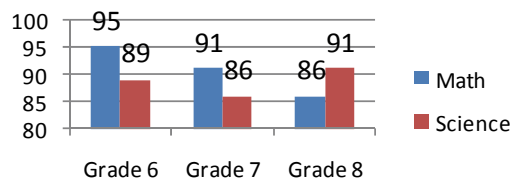


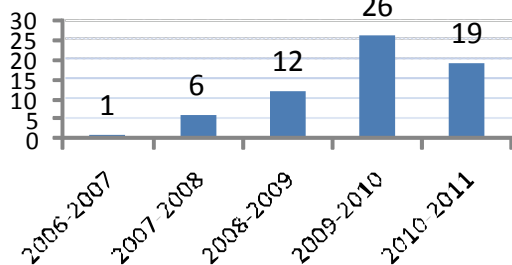
2010 PASS ELA & Writing Passing %



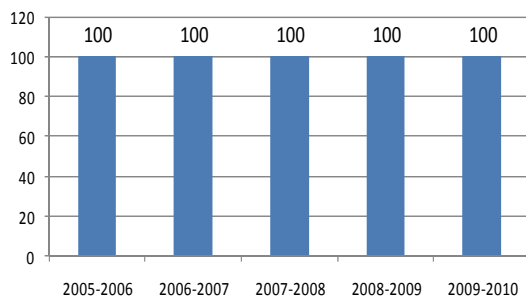
2010 PASS Math & Science Passing %
