Each year our school puts together a school musical encompassing all of our fine arts majors. Students have the opportunity and are encouraged to audition and participate in a variety of ways.

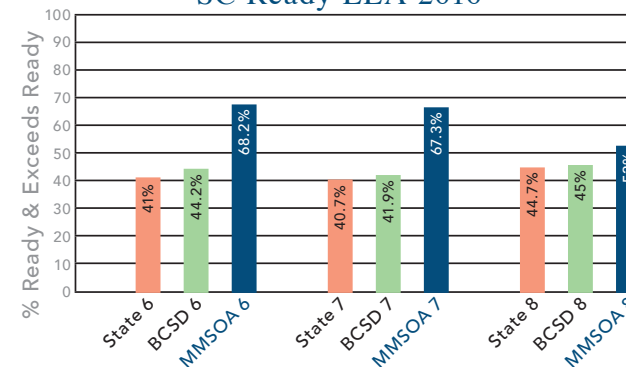

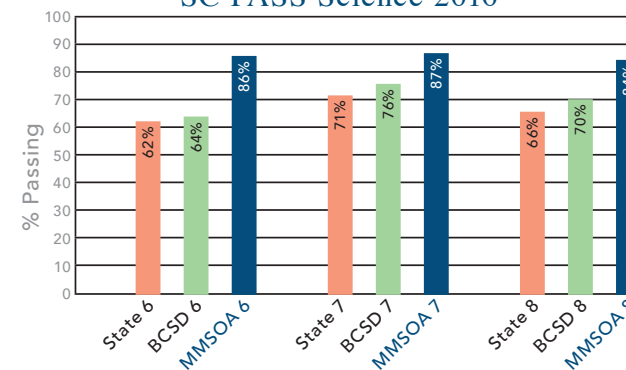

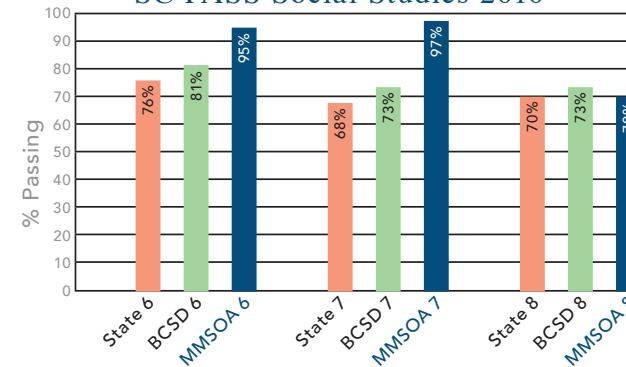
