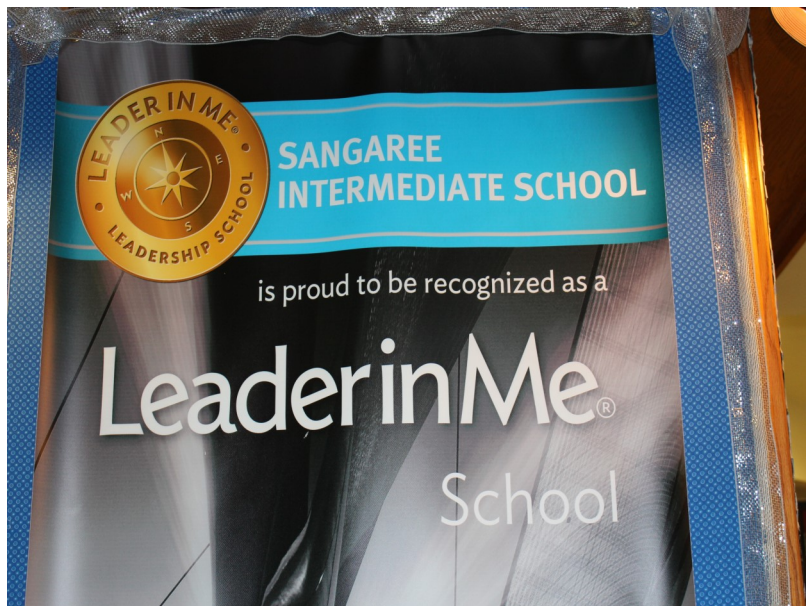
Our Third through Fifth grade students participated in the SC Ready State Assessment in the Spring of 2021.

It has been a wonderful year having our students back in the building. We set a Wildly Important Goal of Multiplication Fact Fluency for all of our students in grades 3-5. Our baseline data was 22%. Our students grew from 22%-86% by May 1st. Many of our classes surpassed the school goal and reached 100% mastery. We also set a Reading Fluency W.I.G. in January. Our baseline data was 108 correct words per minute and by May 1st we have reached 129. We are still short of the school goal of 140 in Reading Fluency but students and teachers are working hard.
