NWEA Measures of Academic Progress

MAP is an adaptive computerized test in Reading and Mathematics taken three times each year. These tests are used to measure students' progress or growth in school.

The assessment is designed to target a student's academic performance in mathematics and reading. These tests are tailored to an individual's current achievement level. The computer adjusts the difficulty of the questions so that each student takes a unique test.
