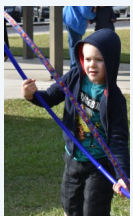

Mount Holly Elementary School has been recertified as a Leader in Me Lighthouse School! The recertification process occurs every 2 years. Areas of strengths identified were student leadership roles, aligned school goals, and leadership portfolios.

Along with classroom leadership roles such as Class Ambassador, Teacher Assistant, Tech Helper, Librarian, and Messenger, students also assume school wide leadership roles. This year, we have approximately 40 different leadership roles available with 32 staff/teachers sponsoring those roles. School Wide roles include Photographers, Welcome Wagon, Honor Guard, MHE Express, News Anchors, and Notebook Navigators, among many others.

The eight habits learned through the LIM model directly align with the Berkeley County Work and Life skills. Students utilize Leadership Notebooks to track academic and personal goals. Once goals are achieved, we take time to celebrate our success!

Students showcase their skills and talents during our annual Leadership Day. This student-led event helps us show our parents and community members how our students are learning to lead.
