Mount Holly Elementary School is a Leader in Me Lighthouse School. The LIM model fosters a sense of intrinsic motivation within each student to succeed academically and to demonstrate positive character. Students assume key leadership roles within the school. The Student Lighthouse Team meets to discuss ideas for improving the school and ways to support the community. The eight habits learned through the LIM model directly align with the knowledge, skills, and characteristics outlined in the profile of the South Carolina graduate. Through integrated instruction of the habits, our students experience academic success in school and transfer the habits into their lives outside of school. Students utilize Leadership Notebooks to track academic and personal goals, data, and celebrations. Students voice and choice is promoted and valued at MHE.

This school year, MHE achieved Lighthouse Recertification. Lighthouse status is recognized in 2 year increments.

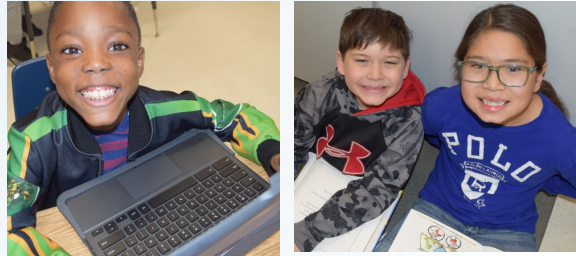
