Our Mission

The mission of Langley Bath Clearwater Middle School is to deliver quality instruction that fosters high academic achievement and social development in a safe and nurturing environment in collaboration with the home and community.

Synergistic Lab

LBC's 7th and 8th graders visit the lab throughout the year with their Science and Math teachers. They explore such concepts as Robotics, Energy Power & Mechanics, Plastics & Polymers, and Alternative Energy with the hands-on, interactive, electronic modules in the lab.

Academics

- Our students have earned 19,000 Accelerated Reader points this year.
- 100% of our English I students passed the EOC test.
- 14 Duke Tip Scholars
- LBC offers 5 subjects for high school credit: English I, Algebra I, Spanish, Keyboarding, and Strings.
- Our GT students went on a field trip to Florida. They visited Universal Studios, Kennedy Space Center, Daytona Speedway, and Arabian Nights Dinner Theatre.

Extracurricular Activities

Our sports and fine arts programs offer wonderful opportunities for our students. We offer sports teams including: football, basketball, volleyball, cheerleading, golf and bowling. We also have band, strings, and chorus. Our students also participate in a variety of academic and service organizations to include the academic team, Beta club, yearbook, student council and the news crew. The Yearbook Staff worked diligently and hard to highlight and commemorate the 2010-2011 school year.

Some of our Points of PRIDE:

Strings Program

LBC is proud to be one of the few middle schools that offers strings for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students. As well as performing for the school and community, 31 students were chosen for the Aiken All-County Strings Festival. Our students have had the privilege of working with members of the Graduate Strings Ensemble for USC Columbia as well as the Julliard String Quartet from New York City.

Chorus

The LBC Choral program consistently performs at Veteran's Day, Christmas, Black History Month, as well as a Spring performance in the school and community. They had the pleasure of working with faculty members from the Julliard School of Music in New York City. In addition, they are currently working on a production of High School Musical. Eighth grade chorus is currently offered for high school credit.

Band

The band traveled to Charlotte to participate in the Carowinds Festival of Music, along with bands from across the Southeast. The LBC Band performed 3 selections and made superior on all 3.

Golf

Our golf team had the best year ever. Our players were committed and their skills greatly improved. We had a 1st and a 2nd place finish.

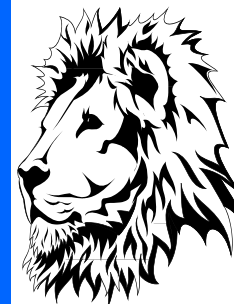
Our best golfer was Race King.
