ASSESSMENTS

<u>AlMSweb</u> - Kindergarten through second grade students are given AlMSweb benchmark assessments in ELA and Mathematics. Teachers use the data collected to plan for instruction and remediation.

Cog/AT and IOWA - These nationally normed tests are administered to our second graders each year to identify children for Berkeley County School District's Gifted and Talented programs. Students take these tests in November, and results are received in January. This year, 7 students automatically qualified for the gifted and talented program for next school year. Additionally, 24 second grade students qualified for further testing.

<u>Common Assessments</u> - Teachers work together in Professional Learning Communities to create common assessments based on state standards. Results are used to plan for instruction and remediation.



CSU students worked with our teachers twice this year to make our WVP Family Curriculum nights a huge success! Students engaged in math and reading activities that could also be played at home to reinforce BCSD curriculum. The CSU students also demonstrated iPad educational applications for parents and students.
